

ULTIMATUM

Meaning: An ultimatum is a final demand or statement of terms, the rejection of which may lead to severe consequences or the breakdown of negotiations.

1. The company issued an ultimatum to the striking workers, demanding they return to their positions by the end of the week.
2. After months of negotiations, the diplomat presented an ultimatum to the rival nation, insisting on a resolution within 48 hours.
3. Feeling cornered, she decided to give her partner an ultimatum about their future together.
4. The United Nations often finds itself in precarious situations where it must deliver an ultimatum to maintain peace.
5. In a tense standoff, the coach delivered an ultimatum to the team: win the next game or face serious consequences.

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
