

ULTRAMONTANIST

Meaning: Ultramontanist: a supporter of the belief in the supreme authority of the Pope over all church matters, emphasizing centralized leadership in the Catholic Church.

1. The ultramontanist perspective emphasizes the authority of the papacy over local church governance.
2. In the debate over church authority, ultramontanists argued for a strong centralized leadership under the Pope.
3. Many ultramontanists viewed the Vatican as the ultimate source of moral and religious guidance.
4. The rise of ultramontanism in the 19th century significantly influenced Catholic doctrine and practice.
5. Critics of ultramontanism contended that it undermined the autonomy of national churches.

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
