Meaning: Umbellic: relating to or resembling an umbel, a cluster of flowers or leaves arranged on stalks that radiate from a common point.

1. The umbellic structure of the flower makes it easily recognizable among other plants.
2. In botany, the umbellic arrangement of the petals creates a stunning visual symmetry.
3. The artist drew inspiration from the umbellic patterns found in nature, incorporating them into her designs.
4. During the hike, we stumbled upon a rare umbellic species that thrived in the shaded area of the forest.
5. The umbellic form of the plant supports a diverse ecosystem by attracting various pollinators.
