Meaning: Umbery: resembling or characterized by a warm, earthy brown color, often associated with shades found in nature, particularly in autumnal landscapes.

1. The artist chose an umbery palette to evoke the warmth of autumn in her landscape painting.
2. As the sun set, the sky turned a deep umbery hue, casting a glow over the horizon.
3. The earthy umbery tones of the clay gave the pottery a rustic charm that appealed to buyers.
