Meaning: Umbilicus: the small scar on the abdomen marking the spot where the umbilical cord was attached, commonly known as the navel or belly button.

2. In anatomical studies, the umbilicus is often referred to as the navel or belly button.
3. After birth, the umbilicus closes off and becomes a small scar on the abdomen.
