Meaning: UMBLES (verb): To make a mistake or blunder, especially in speech or while trying to express oneself.

1. He often stumbles over his words when he's nervous, but he never truly fumbles.
2. The speaker's voice wavered as he fumbled for the right words to convey his thoughts.
3. In her excitement, she might fumble the details of the story, but her enthusiasm is contagious.
4. As the cat chased the string, it would often fumble and tumble in its playful antics.
5. During the rehearsal, he fumbled with the script, struggling to remember his lines.
