Meaning: Umbo: a rounded, protruding part or boss, typically found on shells or armor, serving both a distinguishing and protective function.

1. The umbo of the shell is often the first feature that catches a marine biologist's eye.
2. In medieval armor, the umbo served both a decorative and a functional purpose, providing extra protection for the wearer.
3. The umbo can be an important indicator of the age and growth patterns of certain mollusks.
4. Archaeologists found several umbos in the ancient ruins, hinting at the craftsmanship of the period.
5. The unique shape of the umbo helps researchers identify different species of clams in their habitat.
