Meaning: Unapplicable: not relevant or appropriate to a particular situation or context.

1. The policy was deemed unaplicable in this particular case.
2. Her arguments were so flawed that they became entirely unaplicable to the discussion.
3. The guidelines were found to be unaplicable to the new technology introduced by the company.
4. In this situation, the previous regulations were simply unaplicable to the current circumstances.
5. The judge ruled that the law was unaplicable to the defendant's unique situation.
