*Meaning: To unbind means to free or remove the bindings or restraints from something, such as a book or a knot.*

2. It took her hours to unbind the tightly knotted rope that had secured the cargo.
3. The artist wanted to unbind her creativity from conventional techniques.
4. After the ceremony, they would unbind the ribbons and let the balloons fly free.
5. He felt the need to unbind himself from the expectations placed upon him by others.
