Meaning: Uncock: to release or disengage a mechanism, typically to render it safe or inactive, or to retract a previously held position or argument.

1. He had to uncock the gun before safely storing it in the cabinet.
2. After the intense debate, she decided to uncock her argument and listen to the opposing views.
3. The mechanic showed him how to uncock the car's hood latch properly.
4. To ensure safety, remember to uncock the weapon after each use at the range.
5. In a moment of frustration, he needed to uncock his emotions before addressing the team.
