

UNCOMBINE

Meaning: Uncombine (verb): to separate or isolate components that have been previously mixed or combined.

1. To uncombine the ingredients, simply separate the dry components from the wet ones.
2. The scientist aimed to uncombine the mixed samples to analyze each substance individually.
3. In order to uncombine the colors, she gently poured the paint into separate containers.
4. They decided to uncombine their joint venture to pursue individual projects that suited their interests.
5. The software allowed users to uncombine files that had been merged for easier editing and organization.
