

UNCREDIT

Meaning: Uncredit (verb): to fail to acknowledge or cite someone's contributions or work.

1. The artist felt disheartened when her work was uncited in the exhibition catalog.
2. Despite his contributions, many of his ideas remained uncited in the published study.
3. She was frustrated that her hard work had gone uncaptured and uncited in the final report.
4. In academic circles, failing to credit sources can lead to accusations of unintentional plagiarism.
5. The researchers were careful to ensure that all collaborators were acknowledged and none went uncited.
