Meaning: Uncreditable: not deserving of belief or trust; unreliable or implausible.

1. The accusations against him were so uncreditable that they fell apart under scrutiny.
2. Her uncreditable claims about the product's effectiveness led to a decline in customer trust.
3. It was uncreditable to think that such a reputable organization would engage in unethical practices.
4. The journalist faced backlash for spreading uncreditable rumors without any evidence.
5. His uncreditable performance in the debate left the audience questioning his qualifications.
