*Meaning: Underhew: to partially cut or shape something, creating a desired form or effect, often resulting in an unfinished or raw appearance.*

1. He decided to underhew the tree to create a clearer view of the lake.
2. The artist chose to underhew the canvas, giving it an imperfect texture that enhanced the painting.
3. In an effort to modernize the park, the city planners proposed to underhew some of the old benches.
4. As part of their renovation, they planned to underhew the wooden beams to maintain historical accuracy.
5. To fit the new design, they needed to underhew the doorframe for a more seamless entry.
