

UNDERPITCH

Meaning: Underpitch (verb): to sing or play a note at a pitch that is lower than the intended or correct pitch.

1. The musician realized that he had underpitched the note during the live performance.
2. In the final mix, the vocalist's voice sounded underpitched, affecting the overall harmony.
3. The director asked the composer to adjust the underpitched sections of the score for better resonance.
4. Despite the underpitches, the band managed to create an interesting and unique sound.
5. She was frustrated by the underpitch in her recording, prompting her to redo the session.
