

UNDERPROP

Meaning: Underprop: to support or brace a structure from underneath to enhance its stability or prevent collapse.

1. The engineers decided to underprop the structure to ensure its stability during the renovation.
2. In an effort to prevent the roof from collapsing, they used steel beams to underprop the entire building.
3. The old bridge was underproped with wooden supports while the construction team worked on repairs.
4. They needed to underprop the foundation to address the sinking issue that had developed over the years.
