Meaning: Undersay: to express or state something less emphatically or fully than is warranted.

1. In his attempt to be humble, he tended to undersay his accomplishments during the interview.
2. The teacher encouraged the students to express themselves fully rather than undersay their thoughts.
3. When asked about her achievements, she often undersays her contributions to the project.
4. It's common for many artists to undersay the significance of their work in public discussions.
5. He realized that to gain respect, he needed to stop undersaying his expertise in the field.
