Meaning: Undersheriff: a deputy sheriff who assists the sheriff in managing the operations of a sheriff's department and may assume the sheriff's duties in their absence.

1. The undersheriff was responsible for overseeing the day-to-day operations of the sheriff's department.
2. During the meeting, the undersheriff presented a detailed report on crime statistics for the past year.
3. In many counties, the undersheriff acts as the second-in-command to the elected sheriff.
4. After years of service, the undersheriff was promoted to sheriff following the retirement of his boss.
5. The community held a town hall to discuss the role of the undersheriff in improving public safety.
