Meaning: Undershoot: to fail to reach or achieve a desired point or target, often resulting in a less than intended outcome.

1. The athlete managed to undershoot the jump, landing awkwardly on the mat.
2. Despite careful calculations, the rocket's trajectory caused it to undershoot its target by several miles.
3. The company's revenue projections undershot expectations, leading to a drop in stock prices.
4. In his attempt to impress the judges, the performer undershot the final note, leaving the audience disappointed.
