Meaning: Understatement: a statement that intentionally downplays the significance or intensity of something, often to create a contrasting effect.

1. Saying that the movie was merely "good" was a significant understatement of its brilliance.
2. Her calm reaction to the chaotic situation was an understatement of her true emotions.
3. Describing the hurricane as a "strong wind" was an understatement that misled many residents.
4. His claim that the project faced "some challenges" was an understatement that downplayed the serious issues at hand.
5. The teacher's praise of the student's work as "adequate" was an understatement of the exceptional effort put in.
