Meaning: Undirectly: in a manner that is not direct or straightforward, often implying an indirect influence or responsibility.

1. The impact of the new policy will affect the economy undirectly through changes in consumer behavior.
2. She felt undirectly responsible for the team's failure, as her suggestions had gone unheeded.
3. The artist conveyed her thoughts undirectly, allowing viewers to interpret the meaning in their own way.
4. His influence was undirectly evident in the way the project evolved over time.
5. Though he never mentioned it, his actions undirectly encouraged her to pursue her dreams.
