Meaning: Undraw: to remove or erase previously drawn lines or features in order to simplify or alter a design or composition.

1. The artist decided to undraw the previous lines to create a more fluid composition.
2. In an effort to simplify the design, the architect chose to undraw some of the original features.
3. She felt the need to undraw her assumptions about the situation after hearing his explanation.
4. The teacher encouraged the students to undraw their initial thoughts and rethink the problem.
5. As he reflected on his past, he wished he could undraw certain choices he had made.
