

UNEMPIRICALLY

Meaning: Unempirically refers to conclusions or theories that are based on reasoning or speculation rather than on direct observation or empirical evidence.

1. The theory was criticized for being formulated unemperically, lacking sufficient observational evidence.
2. Many scientists argue that conclusions drawn unemperically can lead to misleading results.
