Meaning: Unequally: in a manner that is not even or fair in distribution or allocation.

1. The resources were distributed unequally among the various departments.
2. In the debate, she argued that opportunities are often allocated unequally across different socioeconomic groups.
3. Their relationship became strained when they realized they were contributing unequally to the household expenses.
4. The effects of climate change are felt unequally, with vulnerable communities facing the greatest challenges.
5. During the experiment, the substances mixed unequally, leading to skewed results.
