Meaning: Unfrock: to deprive a clergyman of his clerical status or office, typically as a result of misconduct.

1. The scandal led the bishop to unfrock himself in a moment of deep shame.
2. After the investigation revealed misconduct, the church decided to unfrock the priest.
3. In a rare move, the committee chose to unfrock the influential pastor amid allegations of abuse.
4. The decision to unfrock the rabbi was met with mixed reactions from the congregation.
5. She had heard rumors that the televangelist might be unfrocked due to financial impropriety.
