

# UNIFOLIATE

*Meaning: Unifoliate refers to a botanical characteristic of plants that have only one leaf per node.*

1. The botanical term "unifoliate" refers to plants that have a single leaf per node.
2. In our garden, the unifoliate species thrives in the sunny spot by the fence.
3. The unifoliate structure of the plant allowed it to conserve water during the dry season.
4. Researchers noted that the unifoliate nature of the vine gave it a unique advantage in its habitat.
5. Unifoliate plants are often easier to identify due to their distinctive leaf arrangement.
