

UNIMPLICATE

Meaning: To unimplicate means to clear someone from involvement or complicity in a crime or wrongdoing.

1. The evidence presented in court was sufficient to unimplicate the defendant from the crime.
2. Her testimony served to unimplicate several individuals who had been wrongfully accused.
3. Despite the initial suspicions, the investigation aimed to unimplicate those who had been misidentified.
4. The new findings helped to unimplicate the scientist from any allegations of misconduct.
5. To unimplicate the innocent parties, the team had to re-examine all the available data.
