Meaning: UNKED: (verb) rendered abstract or obscured, often in a way that distorts clarity or meaning.

1. The artist's work was so abstract that it felt like it had been unked by a surrealist's hand.
2. After the meeting, the project manager realized that several important points had been unked in the discussion.
3. Her response was so vague that it left everyone feeling unked and confused about the next steps.
4. In the game, players could choose to have their characters unked to create a unique experience.
