

UNLAND

Meaning: To remove the designation of land for a specific use, such as agricultural or commercial, allowing for alternative development or use.

1. The new policy aims to unland areas that have been unnecessarily designated as agricultural.
2. Developers are pushing to unland the prime waterfront property for residential use.
3. In an effort to restore the ecosystem, the city plans to unland parts of the industrial zone.
4. Activists argue that we must unland the protected spaces to allow for natural regeneration.
5. To promote urban green spaces, officials are considering ways to unland some commercial districts.
