

# UNLEAVENED

*Meaning: Unleavened refers to bread made without leavening agents, resulting in a flat texture, commonly associated with religious traditions such as Passover.*

1. The tradition of eating unleavened bread during Passover symbolizes the haste with which the Israelites left Egypt.
2. Many cultures have their own versions of unleavened bread, often served during religious ceremonies.
3. In the recipe, use unleavened flour to ensure the dough does not rise while baking.
4. The unleavened wafers were distributed to the congregation during the special service.
5. Unleavened bread has a unique texture that contrasts with the lightness of leavened varieties.
