Meaning: Unline (verb): To remove or eliminate a lining from an object, such as a painting or garment, often to achieve a desired aesthetic effect.

1. The artist decided to unline the painting to create a more abstract effect.
2. After much consideration, she chose to unline her dress to enhance its elegance.
3. In order to improve the overall design, the architect suggested they unline the existing features.
4. To achieve a minimalist look, he opted to unline the garden paths.
5. The editor recommended that the author unline several sections of the manuscript for clarity.
