

UNMERCHANTABLE

Meaning: Unmerchantable refers to goods that are damaged or defective to the extent that they cannot be sold or are unsuitable for sale.

1. The damaged goods were deemed unmerchantable and had to be discarded.
2. After the inspection, the company found that a significant portion of the inventory was unmerchantable.
3. Due to spoilage, the fruits were declared unmerchantable and could not be sold.
4. The unmerchantable items in the warehouse were marked for disposal to free up space.
5. Retailers often struggle with how to manage unmerchantable stock effectively.
