

UNMORTISE

Meaning: Unmortise: to remove or disengage the mortise joints from a structure or object, typically for the purpose of making adjustments or repairs.

1. The carpenter decided to unmortise the joints to make adjustments to the frame.
2. To repair the antique furniture, he had to unmortise several sections carefully.
3. They found it easier to unmortise the pieces rather than attempt a full restoration.
4. After evaluating the structure, the architect recommended unmortising the load-bearing walls.
