Meaning: Unmail (verb): To remove fasteners or bindings from a package or letter in order to open or access its contents.

1. She needed to unmail the package before sending it off again.
2. To unmail the letter, he carefully removed the staples that held it together.
3. After receiving the wrong documents, she had to unmail the entire set to get the correct ones.
4. In a fit of frustration, he decided to unmail the invitation and start fresh.
5. The task to unmail the contents of the envelope was more tedious than she anticipated.
