

UNNATURALIZE

Meaning: Unnaturalize: to make something less natural or instinctive, often by introducing external influences or stimuli that alter typical behaviors or responses.

1. The researchers aimed to unnaturalize the behaviors that had become second nature in the study participants.
2. By introducing artificial stimuli, they hoped to unnaturalize the typical responses observed in the experiment.
3. Art critics often argue that the artist's intent was to unnaturalize the beauty of nature through abstraction.
4. In an effort to unnaturalize traditional narratives, the playwright incorporated unconventional storytelling techniques.
5. The documentary sought to unnaturalize the concept of perfection in social media portrayals.
