Meaning: Unpardonable means incapable of being forgiven or excused due to the severity of the wrongdoing.

1. His betrayal was unpardonable, leaving scars that would never heal.
2. The judge deemed the defendant's actions unpardonable and sentenced him to life in prison.
3. In her eyes, forgetting their anniversary was an unpardonable offense.
4. The historian argued that some atrocities were so heinous they were truly unpardonable.
5. For many, the unpardonable nature of his mistake meant he would never regain their trust.
