

UNPIN

Meaning: Unpin: to remove a fixed or highlighted status from an item, such as a document or application, allowing it to no longer be easily accessible or prominently displayed.

1. You can unpin the document from your taskbar if you no longer need quick access to it.
2. To reorganize your workspace, remember to unpin the apps that you rarely use.
3. After finishing the project, I decided to unpin the folder from my desktop.
4. She quickly learned how to unpin the sticky notes from her screen to declutter her view.
5. If you unpin the message, it will no longer appear at the top of your chat list.
