

UNPROP

Meaning: Unprop (verb): to remove support from an object or structure, causing it to become unstable or collapse.

1. The team's decision to unprop the heavy shelving unit led to it collapsing unexpectedly.
2. To ensure safety, they decided to unprop the supports before moving the structure.
3. You should always unprop the equipment before performing maintenance checks.
4. After the storm, we had to unprop the fallen tree to clear the road.
5. He carefully unprop the tent to pack it away after the camping trip.
