

UNPROTESTANTIZE

Meaning: Unprotestantize: to remove or diminish Protestant influences or characteristics from a system, curriculum, or belief, often in favor of incorporating a broader range of theological perspectives.

1. The initiative aimed to unprotestantize the educational curriculum, integrating diverse theological perspectives.
2. Efforts to unprotestantize the church's teachings led to a more inclusive interpretation of scripture.
