

UNREEVE

Meaning: To unreeve means to remove a rope or line from a block or similar device by pulling it out.

1. To unreeve the rope from the block, he carefully pulled on the end.
2. She had to unreeve the fishing line after it got tangled in the weeds.
3. The sailor decided to unreeve the halyard to make the sail easier to manage.
4. After the storm, they needed to unreeve the lines to check for any damage.
5. It took longer than expected to unreeve the old cable from the winch.
