

UNRIG

Meaning: Unrig: to dismantle or remove the rigging or equipment from a structure, vessel, or machinery.

1. The engineer had to unrig the complex machinery after it was assembled incorrectly.
2. To ensure safety, the crew needed to unrig the sails before the storm hit.
3. After the event, they decided to unrig the decorations and return the venue to its original state.
4. As the boat rocked in the waves, the captain ordered the team to unrig the ropes securing the sails.
5. It took several hours to unrig the tangled wires from the old sound system before they could set up the new one.
