

UNSEAM

Meaning: To unseam means to separate or open the seams of a garment or object, typically to repair or alter it.

1. The tailor had to unseam the dress to fix the uneven hem.
2. After the accident, the seam of the bag began to unseam, spilling its contents everywhere.
3. The fabric was too tightly stitched, causing it to unseam at the corners.
4. During the alteration process, she carefully unseamed the jacket to add more fabric.
5. He watched as the old quilt started to unseam after years of wear and tear.
