*Meaning: Unseem refers to behavior or attire that is inappropriate, unsuitable, or not in keeping with the expected standards of decorum for a particular situation.*

1. His behavior at the formal event seemed unseemly, drawing disapproving glances from the guests.
2. The outfit she chose for the gala was unseem, clashing with the elegant atmosphere of the evening.
3. It is often considered unseem to discuss personal finances in social settings.
4. His loud laughter during the somber ceremony felt unseem to many in attendance.
5. They found it unseem to discuss politics at the family gathering, opting instead for lighter topics.
