Meaning: Unsew: to remove stitches from a sewn item, typically to alter or repair it.

1. Before making the alterations to the garment, she had to unsew the original seams.
2. The tailor advised her to unsew the hem if she wanted to adjust the length of the dress.
3. After realizing the mistake in the stitching, he decided to unsew the panel and start over.
4. To fix the uneven edges, she carefully unsewed the fabric and reattached it.
