Meaning: To unsex means to remove or diminish traditional gender characteristics or traits from a person or character.

1. To unsex a character in literature often means to strip away traditional gender traits.
2. The artist aimed to unsex the subject of the painting, focusing on universal human experiences.
3. In discussions about clothing, the designer sought to unsex fashion by creating gender-neutral pieces.
4. The concept of unsexing is prevalent in debates about identity and societal roles.
5. By unsexing the narrative, the author allowed readers to engage with the story without preconceived notions of gender.
