Meaning: To unsling means to remove or detach something that is slung over the shoulder or body, often with a quick motion.

1. He decided to unsling his backpack and rest for a moment by the riverbank.
2. With a swift motion, she unslung the camera from her neck to capture the breathtaking sunset.
3. The soldier was instructed to unsling his rifle before entering the briefing room.
4. As the hikers approached the campsite, they began to unsling their heavy gear from their shoulders.
5. He carefully unslung the canvas from the truck, revealing the tools he would need for the job.
