

# UNSOCKET

*Meaning: UNSOCKET (verb): To disconnect or remove a component from its socket or connection point.*

1. The technician decided to unsocket the old component to replace it with a new one.
2. Before you start troubleshooting, make sure to unsocket the device from the power source.
3. He carefully unsocketed the cable to avoid damaging any of the connections.
4. To upgrade the system, you'll need to unsocket several parts and reassemble them later.
5. After the power surge, she had to unsocket the hardware to check for any damage.
