

UNSTACK

Meaning: Unstack (verb): To remove items from a stacked arrangement, typically to reorganize or facilitate access.

1. It took a moment to unstack the boxes without causing them to fall over.
2. She decided to unstack the dishes after dinner to make cleaning easier.
3. The children were excited to unstack the colorful blocks they had just built.
4. In order to find the book, he had to unstack the pile of papers on his desk.
5. He carefully unstacked the wooden chairs to set up for the meeting.
