Meaning: To remove the strings or cords from an object, such as a musical instrument or a tent.

1. The musician decided to unstring his guitar to clean the fretboard thoroughly.
2. Before packing away the tent, we need to unstring the ropes and fold it neatly.
3. She chose to unstring her beads, as she wanted to create a new pattern for her necklace.
4. To properly maintain the bow, it's essential to unstring it after each use.
5. He carefully unstrung the kite to avoid tangling the lines in the wind.
