Meaning: Unteach: to reverse or eliminate learned behaviors, habits, or beliefs.

1. It can be difficult to unteach ingrained habits that have been formed over many years.
2. The new educational approach aimed to unteach outdated beliefs about learning.
3. In therapy, the counselor worked to unteach the client's negative thought patterns.
4. Sometimes, it takes more effort to unteach misinformation than to teach the correct facts.
5. Parents often find it challenging to unteach behaviors that children have picked up from peers.
